Where

In the room right of the coffee machine. Next to the OD machine/near the ice box.

Material needed

Quantity	What
	UV machine Gel, which you want to image.

Steps

- 1. Put the gel into the UVbox. Place it carefully to avoid bubbles close to the region we are interested in.
- 2. Close the door and turn on the UV light.
- 3. Computer: Open Kodak.M1.exe (Use guest account if nobody is logged in.)
- 4. "Capture GL 100" \rightarrow "Preview" \rightarrow "Capture".
- 5. We can adjust brightness or invert colors as desired.
- 6. "File" \rightarrow "Export data" \rightarrow "image" \rightarrow save it on a memory stick.
- 7. Turn off the UV, and throw it away in the "white trash" under the gel bench.
- 8. We can pour the 0.5XTAE which is left in the box back into the bottle.

Warnings

- Do not touch computer keyboard with gloves!!
- Don't look at UV light! Don't turn UV on when box is not closed.
