
Agarose Gel Preparation

- 1. Dissolve 1 gr of agarose in 100 ml of TAE to make a 1% gel. To dissolve, heat in the microwave until the liquid is clear (about 3 minutes)
- 2. Prepare a shell as shown below.



- 3. Move to chemical hood.
- 4. Add 1-2 drops of Ethidium Bromide to the Erlenmeyer and mix (1 drop per 50 ml)
- 5. Spill the liquid into the shell, add the well "comb" and wait for it to solidify
