Laboratory Safety.

The biggest danger in the laboratory is **YOU** if you are either ignorant or careless or both. Know these rules and obey them.

- 1. Never enter a lab. unless you have permission from a member of staff.
- 2. Keep the floor around benches clear of bags and coats.
- 3. Never run or rush about.
- 4. Do not touch anything until told.
- 5. Never throw anything.
- 6. Always wear eye protection when advised.
- 7. Do not allow ties or hair to hang loose during practicals.
- 8. Leave a Bunsen on a yellow flame.
- 9. Hold a burn under cool running water for at least 10 minutes.
- 10. No eating or drinking of anything.
- 11. Do not put anything in your mouth.
- 12. Report all breakages.
- 13. Always wash/clean hands after practicals.
- 14. Never remove anything from a lab. unless instructed to do so.
- 15. Never stand on lab. tables
