## PROCEDURE FOR BEADS CLEANING

ADAPTED FROM THE BONNET TEAM PROTOCOL REPOSITORY

## **PROTOCOL**:

## Used beads should be placed in recipient with bleach before washing.

- 1 Put the beads (without the bleach) in a bucket.
- 2 Add new bleach and water to cover all the beads, wait 30min for full decontamination.
- 3 Remove the bleach, place the beads in a clean bucket and add water. Mix beads and water to be sure that all beads have been in contact with water.
- 4 Re-iterate the previous step.
- 5 Perform step 3 twice with deionized water instead of water.
- 6 Perform step 3 once with ethanol 70°.
- 7 Remove ethanol.
- 8 Clean your bench.
- 9 Dry beads using paper (place paper on your bench, smoothly put beads on it and use paper to dry them).
- 10 Place beads into small bottles (you can use the paper as a funnel).
- 11 Autoclave the bottles.
