
## Phage Fred in search of his friend





Once upon a time there was a phage named Fred.


## Phage Fred's head is very angular. It has as many as twenty triangles!

Every Phage can find a bacterial friend who is the perfect match, but where can we find the bacterial friend of Phage Fred?




Bacteria live everywhere after all!




Phage Fred goes swimming. Fred sees fish, plants and a bacterium. This is Bob. Could Bob the bacterium be Phage Fred's friend?






Phage Fred hugs Bob the bacterium, but Fred's legs do not fit around Bob. That is a shame! Who is Fred's friend then?



Phage Fred does not give up. Fred looks further.




Phage Fred goes looking in the desert. Perhaps there is a friend for Fred. In the desert are camels, palm trees and some grass.




Phage Fred finds Betty the bacterium on the grass. "Hi Bettie, would you like to be my friend?"



Fred hugs Bettie. "Oh no, I can't give you a hug either!" says Fred.




Oh no, what is coming?

Oh no! Phage Fred has been eaten!




It is pitch black. Phage Fred is afraid and does not know where he is. Poor Fred.




Once Phage Fred looks closer, Fred sees that he is in the stomach of the locust. Huh, what does he see?






There are lots of different bacteria. Is Fred's friend among them?
